

Rules for Use of the Flying Field at Carnation Farms During the Coronavirus Crisis

As the coronavirus situation changes over time, these rules will also be subject to change. If in doubt, follow the latest CDC guidelines.

1. Get Vaccinated! If you aren't yet vaccinated, do it!
2. If you test positive for the virus (or are showing symptoms), STAY HOME. If you test positive for the virus and you've been to CF or 60 Acres within the past two weeks, please notify the board so that we can notify other SASS members and CF staff of possible exposure to Coronavirus.
3. Required equipment:
 - Masks are recommended whenever you are within six feet of another person.
 - Masks are required whenever you enter a cattery building.
 - Masks are required whenever you are around CF staff.

4. Flying:

When you are on the field, flying, and are maintaining proper distance from other flyers, a mask is not required.

If you are hobnobbing with other flyers at close range, a mask is recommended. If you are maintaining proper distancing while conversing, a mask is still recommended.

5. Building access:

We have access to our two storage areas, the restroom in the cattery, and the hallways leading to them.

If you enter via the door next to the frequency board, you may access the bathroom via the mud room, not via the kitchen (the one with the sign on the door stating No Admission)

Do not enter any other rooms or any other buildings.

In the past, some flyers have used the restroom in the building nearest the plane-eating tree. DO NOT USE IT.

Wear a mask when inside the cattery!

Maintain social distancing (six feet or more) from CF staff.

Sanitation procedures when using the cattery:

- Wear a mask when inside the cattery! (Yes, I know I'm repeating myself.)
- Wash your hands thoroughly after using the restroom.
- Practice good hand hygiene at all times with soap and water (when available) or hand sanitizer.
